The traditional safety paradigm has focussed on behaviours of individuals and the use of bureaucratic accountability and constraints to prevent negative outcomes. But despite unprecedented investments in safety, organisations still experience significant incident levels. Furthermore, while this approach has led to significant improvements it has also produced several problematic side effects: disengagement and disempowerment of people, increasing bureaucracy, loss of innovation and productivity. Safety differently suggests a paradigm shift in how organisations understand and manage safety. This new paradigm requires new or refocused safety practices as well as new roles for safety professionals and business leaders.
